July Traffic Growing

- Total traffic: 3,166,922, up 7.6%
- Domestic traffic: 2,350,547, up 4.0%
- International traffic: 816,375, up 19.2%
- Total traffic has increased 51 out of the last 52 months
- Year-to-Date (YTD) Total passengers 21,674,454, up 9.7%
- There were 46 more air carrier/air taxi departures vs. July 2017

Airports Council International Rankings for June 2018

- FLL ranked 1st in growth, 12 months ending June 2018, up 10.8%
- 2nd in YTD total growth, up 10.4%
- 9th YTD in total international traffic
- 18th in YTD total passenger traffic

Nine out of FLL's Top 10 Carriers had YTD Growth

New Service

- July: Southwest to San Antonio

New Airlines

- Swoop - Ultra Low Cost Carrier (ULCC) based in Calgary, Canada will start service from Hamilton, Ontario in October with two weekly flights.
- Frontier - Returning to FLL in November with 4 weekly flights to Trenton and Islip.
