June Traffic Growing

- Total traffic: 3,011,746, up 12.5%
- Domestic traffic: 2,271,719, up 8.7%
- International traffic: 740,027, up 26.3%
- Total traffic has increased 50 out of the last 51 months
- Year-to-Date (YTD) Total passenger 18,507,532, up 10.1%.
- There were 13 more scheduled domestic departures and 15 more scheduled international departures vs. June 2017.
