



Message From the CEO

Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe January is already over, and February, with its St. Valentine's and American Heart Health Month festivities, among other annual celebrations, is knocking at our doors. Although the first month of 2024 is in the rear-view mirror, hopefully, you're managing to keep those resolutions in focus as the new year gains momentum.

For 2024, the Broward County Aviation Department (BCAD) is enthusiastic about the ongoing development of key airport projects and amenities such as the new Food Court in Terminal 3's Concourse E, slated to open this summer, and Terminal 5, FLL's new five-gate domestic facility, now under construction for a targeted opening in mid-2026. Meanwhile, over at North Perry Airport (HWO), our general aviation reliever in Pembroke

Pines, projects like the replacement/relocation of the Air Traffic Control Tower and a new Shared Use Path around HWO's perimeter for pedestrians are advancing in the design phase.

A preliminary end of year shows FLL welcomed approximately 35 million travelers in 2023, an increase of 10.4 percent from 31.7 million visitors in 2022, aided by a robust holiday season. For the Christmas/New Year's Day holiday period of December 21 to January 6, FLL served roughly 2.02 million passengers, about 14% more people than the same 2022 period.

As 2024 continues to take shape, BCAD looks forward to keeping our readers informed about noteworthy happenings at our two airports through this monthly newsletter.

Here's to many new journeys together in 2024.
