

## RETURNING FROM A CRUISE

### AT THE SEAPORT

- **Baggage Check-In:** Some airlines have arrangements with baggage companies to process your **baggage directly from your cabin to your airplane** so you are free to tour the area before your flight. You are encouraged to utilize this service, which will allow you more mobility and time, especially for those with departures later in the day.
- **Remember 3-1-1.** Any liquids that are more than 3.4 ounces, including alcohol and perfumes, are not allowed in your carry on baggage. TSA requires that liquids, gels and aerosols are limited to 3.4 ounces in a one quart plastic ziplock bag. **Place liquids over 3.4 ounces in your checked baggage and ensure they are safely packed (visit [www.TSA.gov](http://www.TSA.gov)).**
- **Shore Excursions:** Avoid going to the Airport too early for your flight. Take advantage of the shore excursions offered by your cruise line. Some airlines may not check your baggage earlier than 2 to 3 hours prior to your scheduled departure. You may experience longer than normal check-in lines, especially with morning departures. Contact your airline for check-in times.

### AT THE AIRPORT

- **Baggage Check-In:** Some airlines may not check your baggage earlier than 2 to 3 hours prior to your scheduled departure. You may experience longer than normal check-in lines, especially with morning departures. Contact your airline for check-in times.
- **Busy Cruise Days:** The airlines discourage passengers to "standby" for earlier flights because on cruise days (Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday) flights are booked to capacity. On cruise days, a large number of returning passengers begin arriving at the Airport at 8:30 a.m. for flights scheduled throughout the day. This may result in crowded terminal lobbies and limited seating.
- **Store Baggage:** There are baggage storage concessions in every terminal. Why not store your baggage for the day and tour the city, go shopping or relax at one of our beaches.
- **Car Rentals:** If you have a late departure, instead of spending the day at the Airport, consider renting a car and exploring beautiful South Florida. The Airport's state-of-the-art car rental center is conveniently located across from Terminal 1. Ace, Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, E-Z, Hertz, National, Payless, Royal, and Thrifty are the companies located at the Airport.
