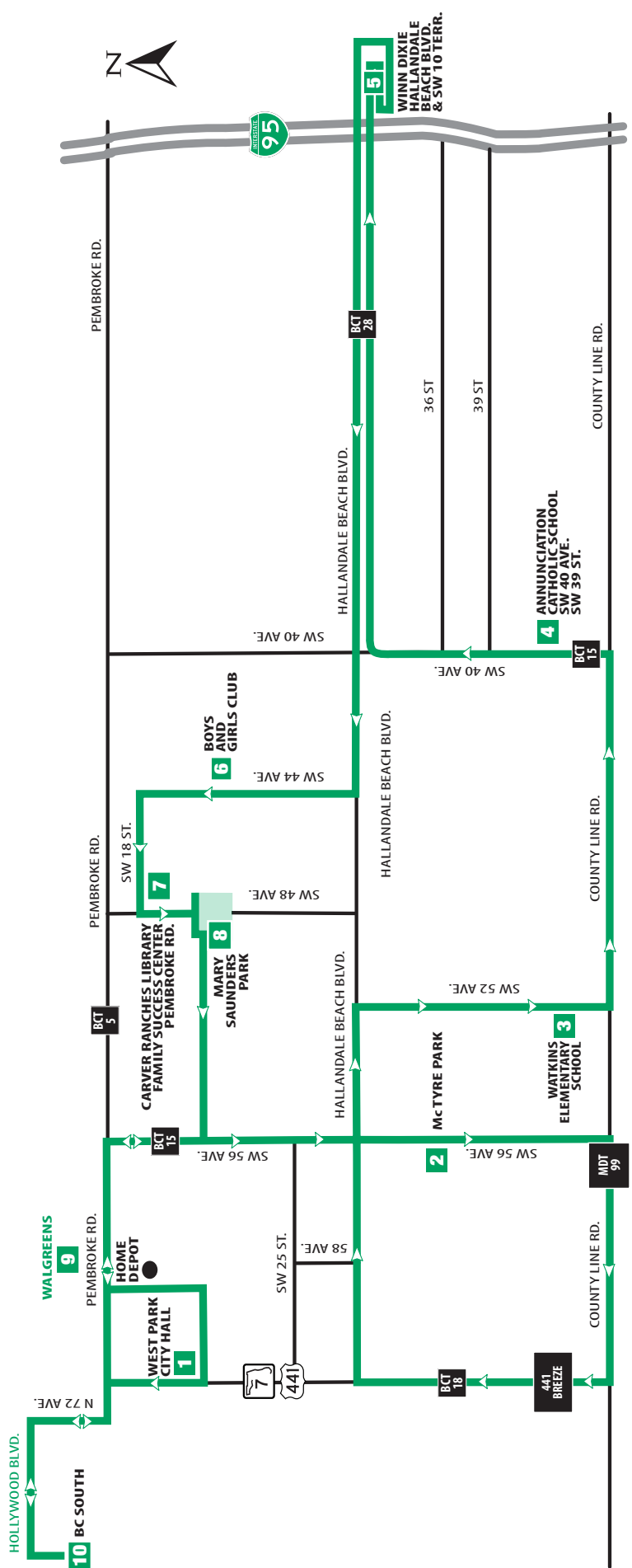

The City of West Park and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide City of West Park Community Shuttle Service. This Community Shuttle Service will increase the number of destinations and connections that can be reached through public transit.

Destinations along this route include West Park City Hall; Home Depot; McTyre Park; Watkins Elementary School; SW 40 Avenue from Countyline Road to Pembroke Road; Annunciation Catholic School; Winn Dixie at Hallandale Beach Boulevard and SW 10 Terrace; Boys and Girls Club along SW 44 Avenue; Mary Saunders Park; Carver Ranches Library and Family Success Center; Walgreens at Pembroke Road and 441; Broward College South Campus and surrounding neighborhoods.

## City of West Park Community Shuttle Service

The Shuttle offers free public transportation—you don't need a car! The Shuttle is FREE, air-conditioned, wheel chair accessible, in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instructions on how to correctly use the bicycle racks. The Shuttle Service is FREE, but riders making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

Connections are available to BCT routes, 5, 7, 15, 18, 28, 441 Breeze, MDT 99, and 95-Express Bus (¾ mile west of the Broward College). Also connects with Miramar Yellow Route Community Bus at US 441 and Pembroke and Miramar Parkway. Hallandale Beach Community Bus Route 3 and 4 at Hallandale Beach Blvd and SW 10 Terrace (Winn Dixie).

## Hours of Operation

**Monday Through Friday**

**7:00 am – 9:00 am • 3:00 pm – 6:12 pm**

The West Park Community Shuttle Service operates approximately every 60 minutes, with assigned stops.

Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The bus

will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions and/or inclement weather may cause the bus to arrive earlier or later than the expected time. Please allow yourself enough time when using this service.

The West Park Community Shuttle Service route will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the bus.

## Bike Racks

Bike racks are available on West Park Community Shuttle Service. Racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the bus approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

### Loading

- Always load your bike from the curb side of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the bus.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

### Unloading

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position. **Move quickly to the curb.**
