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**BROWARD COUNTY, FL** - The "A Way Home" Plan is the focus of the Homeless Continuum of Care Board (CoC Board), providers and community stakeholders, as they work toward preventing and ending the plight of homelessness in Broward County.

In an effort to update and define strategies for the coming year, a "Community Plan Update Charrette" has been organized and all local partners, stakeholders, business owners and community residents are encouraged to attend. A charrette, a facilitated planning process, is designed to help communities gather input to address key issues. The charrette will be held at the Salvation Army, 100 SW 9th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, on Tuesday, November 14th, from 8:30AM- 4:30PM.

The key issues determined by the Homeless CoC Board, Homeless Initiative Partnership, National Alliance to End Homelessness (NAEH) and CSH will include themes generated from interviews, surveys, and focus groups from providers, stakeholders and the CoC Board.
