



- \$1.77 Billion in SIS Modal Funds






Existing, Developing and Proposed Intermodal Logistics Centers Locations











Florida's Seaport Infrastructure

- Since 2011, Florida Governor Scott has invested over \$850
 Million in funding for seaport infrastructure improvements
- In 2013, International trade moving through Florida seaports Florida seaports totaled \$160.5 billion
- \$85.9 billion in waterborne international trade came through Florida ports in 2013, increasing for the fifth year in a row











Perishables Pilot Program

- Allows for the clearance of coldtreatment perishables through south Florida
- Perishable goods from PortMiami / Port Everglades / Port of Palm Beach reach 70% of the U.S. population in 4 days or less
- Allows same-day delivery of perishable goods to markets in Central Florida, with next-day service to markets in Atlanta and the Southeastern U.S.


