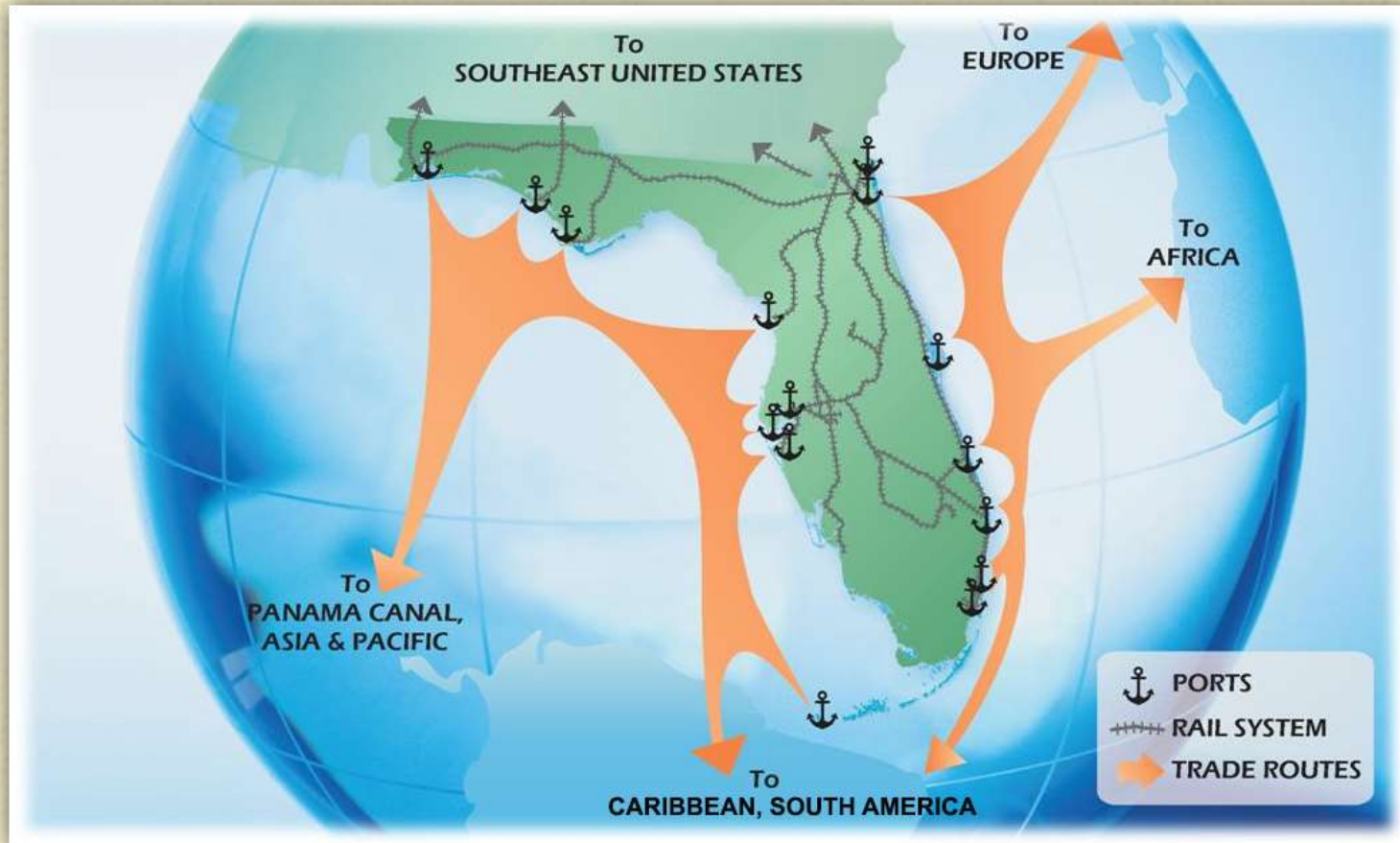

Florida's Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) Funding

- **\$1.77 Billion** in SIS Modal Funds
 - \$929.0 Million State Managed
 - \$838.1 Million Matching Funds
- **Funding by Mode**
 - **Aviation** \$935.4 Million
 - **Space** \$95.3 Million
 - **Rail** \$148.5 Million
 - **Seaport** \$256.7 Million
 - **Transit** \$115.3 Million
 - **Intermodal** \$37.4 Million
 - **Modal Reserve** \$175.3 Million

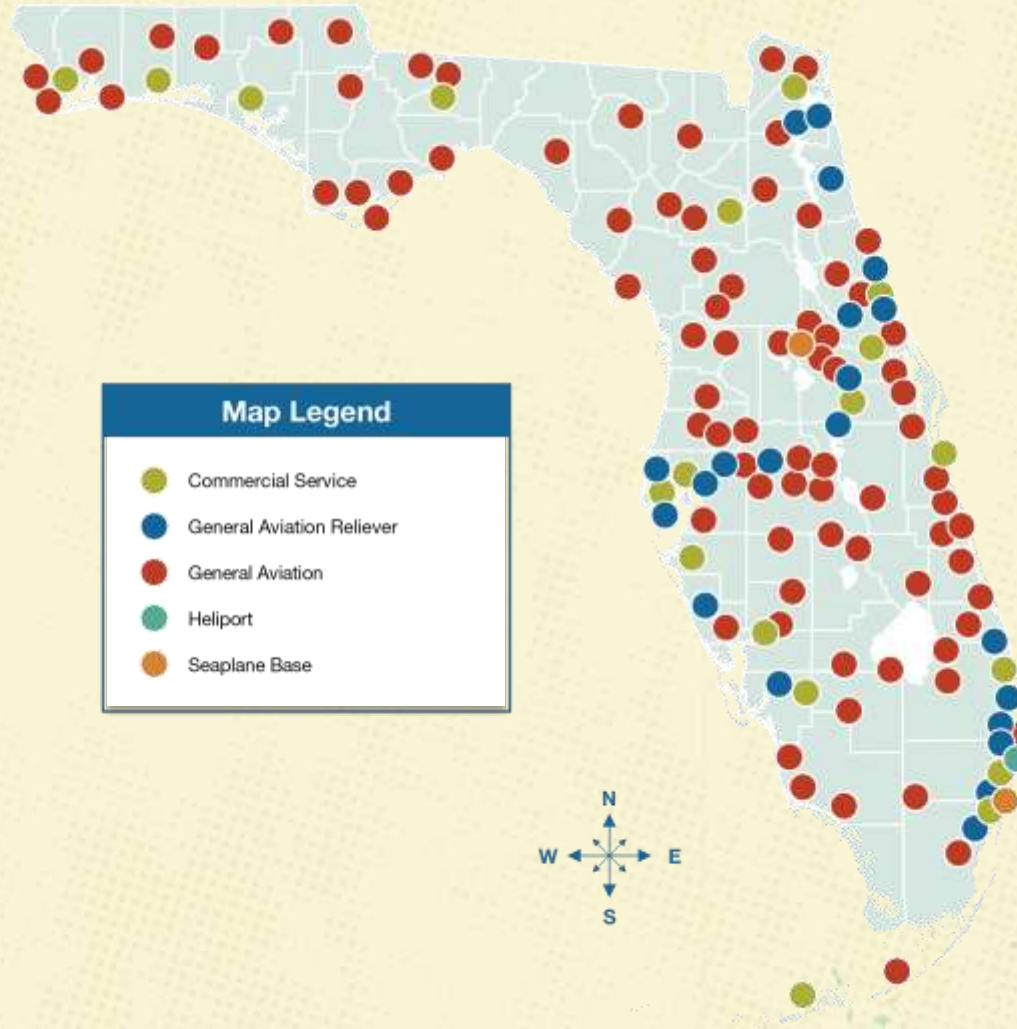
Highway System Overview

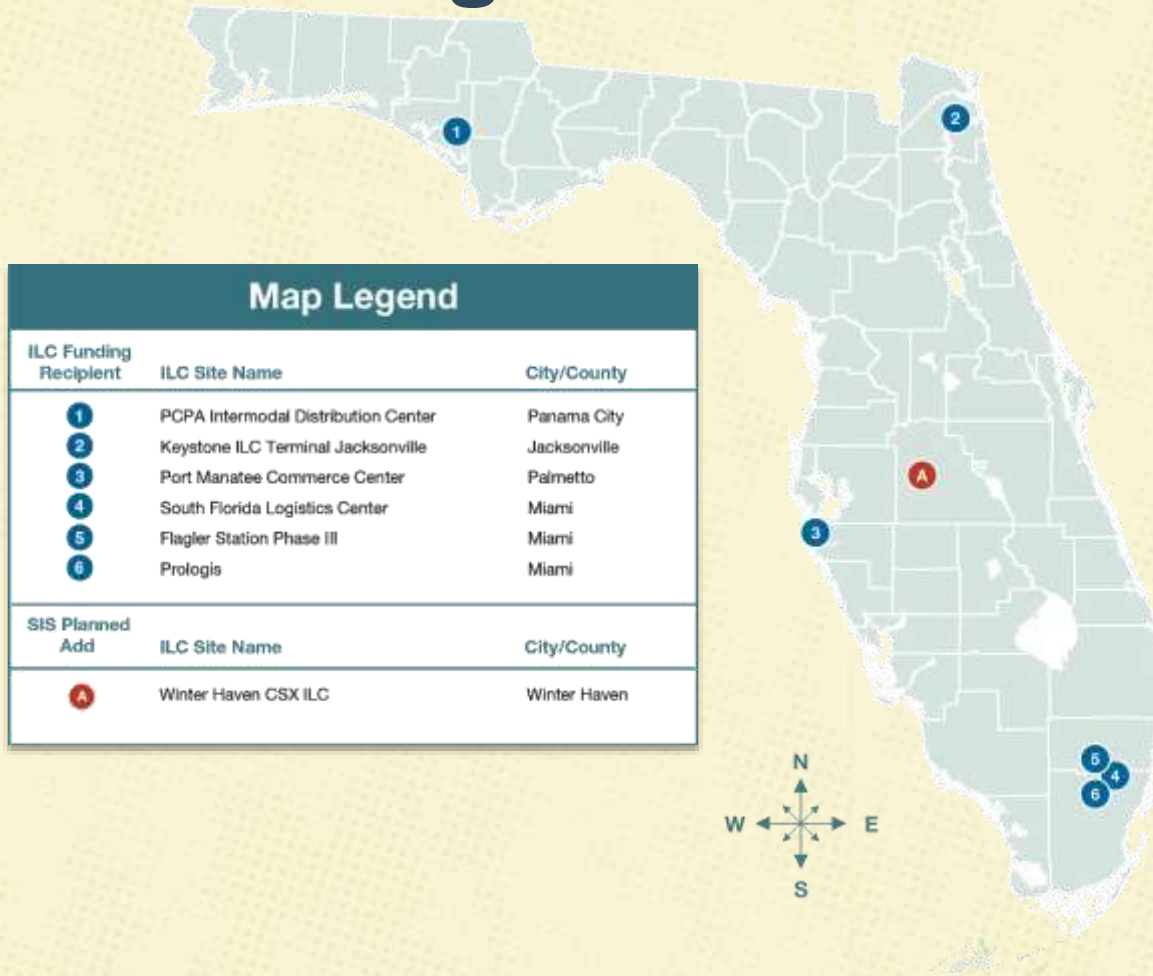

Florida's Seaport Infrastructure

- Since 2011, Florida Governor Scott has invested **over \$850 Million** in funding for seaport infrastructure improvements
- In 2013, International trade moving through Florida seaports Florida seaports **totaled \$160.5 billion**
- \$85.9 billion in waterborne international trade came through Florida ports in 2013, increasing for the **fifth year in a row**



Perishables Pilot Program

- Allows for the clearance of **cold-treatment perishables** through south Florida
- Perishable goods from PortMiami / Port Everglades / Port of Palm Beach reach 70% of the U.S. population in **4 days or less**
- Allows **same-day delivery** of perishable goods to markets in Central Florida, with **next-day service** to markets in Atlanta and the Southeastern U.S.
