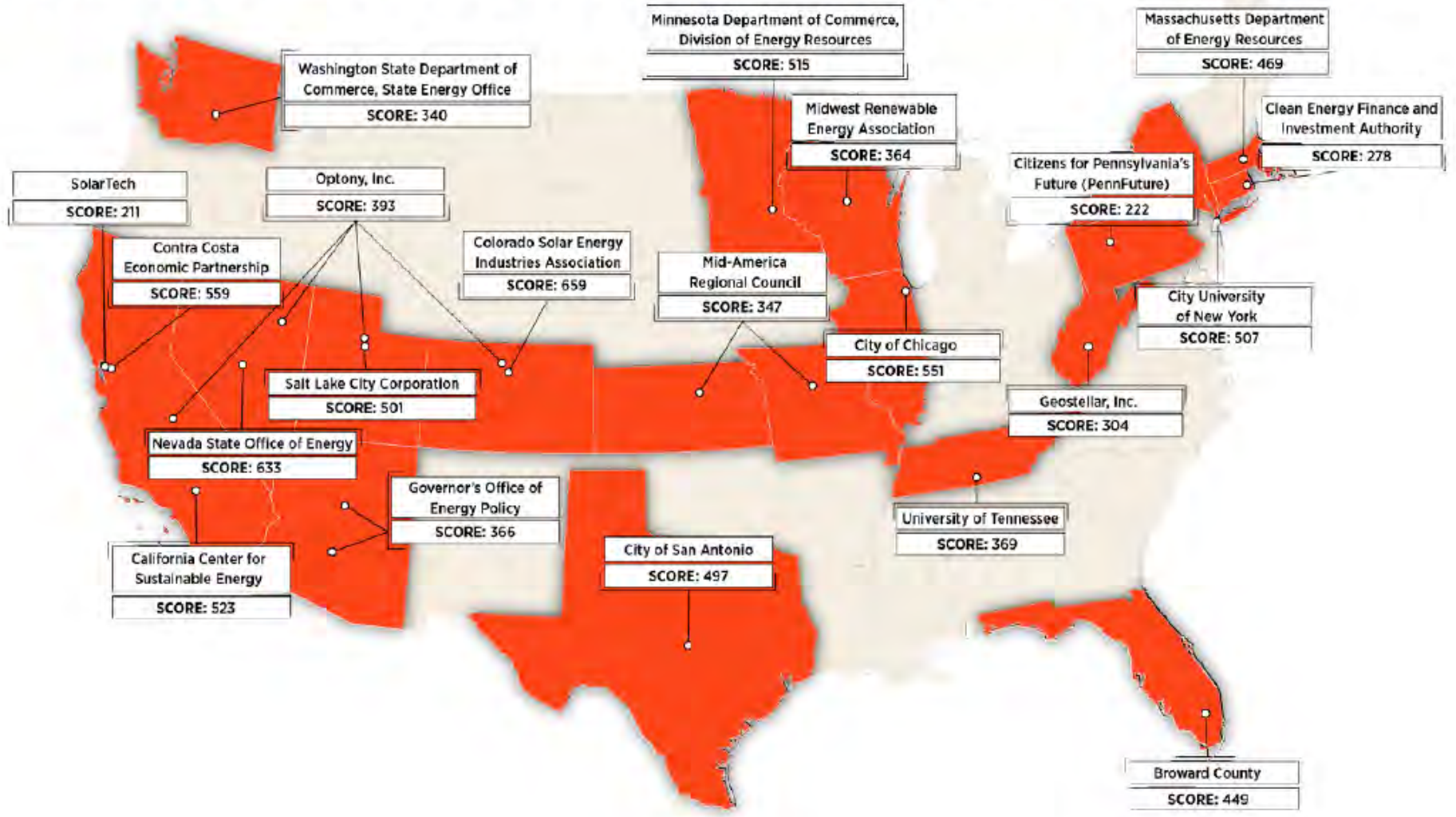




What is Go SOLAR?

- Main purpose is to reduce soft costs

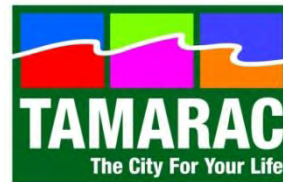
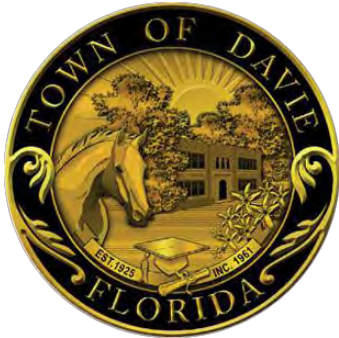
Baseline Market Assessment Scores
