

## Meeting Summary

### Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Reductions Subcommittee

#### Broward County Climate Action Plan Update

Monday, May 4, 2015

4:30PM-6:30PM

1. The meeting began at 4:30PM. Chair Hector Samario welcomed the group and reminded the members of the mission and a few ground rules for the meeting. Introductions were made. 2. Dr. Samantha Danchuk provided a presentation providing follow-up on information requested by the subcommittee, survey results from the electronic survey sent to members, and examples of related strategies from other communities (presentation handout is attached for further review).

      - Redevelopment

  - Encourage refurbish not demo
  - Energy STAR levels
  - Residential

- Water/Energy connection, cross-ref to FL friendly
  - Tropical fruit trees in food deserts
  - Natural systems, trees removed from powerlines
- iv. WR 1.6**
- Grant proposals to bring reclaimed water to communities, FL water star certification
  - “Infrastructure” policy and planning
  - AWA needed?
  - Ask TAC to vet, give target to achieve
  - Need more specific target, water conservation targets

- FL SEC – need more recent update, expand to commercial – Barry, Laura, Chelsea to look into

  - VMT – one spectrum

  - Alt. fuel vehicles
