The Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Broward financing program launched countywide in 26 participating cities and the Broward Municipal Services District in June 2016. Since then, local interest to use PACE to finance qualifying property improvements has continued to steadily increase. More than 13,000 applications have been submitted. There are many reasons why property owners are choosing PACE for improvements such as rooftop solar panels, impact windows, insulation, and more:

- Eliminates large up-front an out-of-pocket costs. Property owners voluntarily agree to the program terms for financing, and repay through a non-ad valorem special assessment added to their property tax bill.
- The annual PACE assessment is partially or wholly offset by electric bill savings and/or insurance savings, and may add value to your home.
- PACE Providers serve as an additional layer between the property owner and the contractor. The contractor does not get paid by the Provider until the property owner signs off.

PACE financing is available to both residential and commercial properties, and there are now five PACE Providers available to compare and choose. To learn more, visit PACE Broward webpage at Broward.org/GoGreen then click PACE.
