PROJECT STATUS

Bailey Road Conflict Zone Painting

The first of the conflict zones along Bailey Road has been painted green to highlight to drivers of the conflict zone and provide awareness to bicyclist safety.

Ravenswood Road

Stirling Road to Griffin Road | Dania Beach

County led Complete Streets project in Dania Beach is currently under design and scheduled for construction in late 2015.

Andrews Ave

Between NE/NW 5th Street and NW/NW 6th Street | Fort Lauderdale

Broward County and Fort Lauderdale staff worked together to approve off-peak on-street parking along Andrews Avenue.

Fort Lauderdale Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Planning Pilot Program Application

The County worked with Fort Lauderdale and other partners to assist in developing an application for the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Pilot Program for TOD Planning around the future WAVE streetcar.

Painted Intersections

County staff has provided support to Fort Lauderdale staff in the city's initiative to artistically paint the intersections of SE 1st, SE 2nd and SE 3rd Avenues to increase awareness of pedestrians and bicyclists.

POLICIES & STANDARDS

Broward County Lane Adjustment Request and Approval Process

Document under development to serve as a guide for reviewing and approving lane adjustments to support complete streets concepts. The Complete Streets Team will be an integral part of the process, including project review and coordination with applicants.

Broward County 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan

Members of the Complete Streets Team played a significant role in the development and review of the Broward County 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), both by serving on the LRTP Steering Committee as well as on the Broward MPO Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) and providing recommendations. This plan, which guides funding for years 2019 through 2040, is instrumental in determining funding decisions for bicycle, pedestrian, transit and roadway projects. Complete Streets Team members placed particular emphasis on the bicycle and pedestrian components of the plan to ensure the progress made over recent years continues into the future.

EDUCATION & OUTREACH

Bicycle Friendly Community Bronze Level Award

Broward County was awarded the bronze level in recognition of the County's commitment to being a bicycle friendly community. The Bicycle Friendly Community program helps communities by providing a roadmap to improve conditions for bicycling and the guidance to make the vision for a better, more bicycle friendly community a reality. Broward County is one of the largest jurisdictions to be recognized as a bicycle friendly community.
