TEMPORARY CHANGE IN FLIGHT PATTERNS DUE TO THE 2007 MCDONALD'S AIR & SEA SHOW FORT LAUDERDALE-HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport's main runway (North Runway), 9L-27R, will be closed for departures, during the times outlined below, to allow the U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds to practice and perform off-shore, east of the airport.

During the closure period, the airport will use Runway 13-31 (The diagonal or crosswinds runway) for departures. Residents living in northeast Dania and southwest Fort Lauderdale may notice an increase in aircraft operations over their communities.

Please note the following dates and times that Runway 13-31 will be used for departures:

- Friday, May 4, 2007: 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 am and 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. (2 hours total)
- Saturday, May 5, 2007: 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. (1 hour)
- Sunday, May 6, 2007: 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. (1 hour)
