Request for Determination of Eligibility Form

Individual Broward-based Practicing Professional Artists

All applicants must meet eligibility requirements at the time of application deadline. The Determination of Eligibility form should be submitted at least 45 calendar days prior to the application deadline for the program for which the applicant plans to apply. This will allow time for the staff to review the request for a determination concerning the artist’s eligibility for BCC grants.

Individual Broward-based practicing professional artists, eighteen (18) years or older, residing in Broward County, and that have lived continuously in Broward County for the immediate twelve consecutive months prior to the filing date of application. The program supports eligible artists who have created a recognized body of original works of art within an artistic discipline over a sustained period of time, and pursue this work as a means of livelihood and/ or a way to achieve the highest level of professional recognition. Broward-based artists should demonstrate a history of professional artistic work during the past year, and the ability to create a strong artistic project and deliver the project at a public venue.

Broward Cultural Division Mini-Grant Program (MGP) - The purpose of the Mini-Grant Program is to assist eligible **Broward-based practicing professional artists**, to fund small but complete, cultural projects, in Broward County, for which applicants have not received grant monies through any other Cultural Division program. The project must be an exhibition, a performance, or other arts activity.

Funds will be available on a non-matching basis for the use of the award recipient to support a project. An individual Broward-based artist may apply for up to \$2,000 per award on a funds available basis. An individual artist may apply for one (1) Mini-Grant per fiscal year and shall not receive in excess of \$2,000 in Mini-Grant funding during any County fiscal year
