# PUBLIC ART & DESIGN

In another groundbreaking year for the Public Art and Design program, much ground was broken. In August, a dedication ceremony announced the installation of Richard Medlock's *Equestrian Oasis* at Sunshine Ranches Equestrian Park. The artwork was designed with functional and artistic elements for horses and riders within a twenty-acre neighborhood park situated in the heart of Broward County's horse country. *Reach for the Stars*, Beth Ravitz's public artwork was hoisted by crane into the courtyard of North County Homeless Assistance Shelter in January 2004; the new Lauderhill Town Center Library received the *Hibiscus II* artwork by Elizabeth Indianos, and four other Broward County libraries received Florida emblematic artwork by public artist Lisa Houck.

Awards were shared too, as the Broward County's Park and Land Bond Master Plan – *Theatre of Regeneration: towards an aesthetic of layers, loops and lenses*, by public artist Lorna Jordan and design team, received accolades with an Environmental Design Research Association (EDRA) Place Planning Award; and James Carpenter, the public artist commissioned to the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport's *Luminous Portals*, was honored as a winner in the 24<sup>th</sup> annual MacArthur Fellowship award—a \$500,000 no-strings attached prize that acknowledges creative thinkers in a wide range of fields.

An annual tour of the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood's Public Art was held in May 2004. Guests included members of the *Florida Association of Public Art Administrators* and interested members of the public. The event toured the four terminals highlighting current public artworks, and surveyed sites for the commissions in progress.

The Duane Hanson Allied Artists for the fiscal year 2004 were Aaron Temkin, with Lorna Jordan on the Parks Bond Public Art Master Plan; public artist Raymond Olivero, with the artist team James Hirschfield and Sonya Ishii on the Broward Boulevard Streetscape; and Cherie Saleeby, with the artist teams Mags Harries and Lajos Heder on the Regional Park at Miramar.
