#### Notes

- 1 Measure is higher than projected due to more Car Care Month activities, more Clean Air Month activities, and more requests for presentations from the public than were anticipated.
- 2 The customer satisfaction survey is reported annually.
- 3 Measure is lower than projected due to meteorological conditions conducive to ozone formation and uncontrolled wildfires. Broward County experienced 26 days of "moderate" and "unhealthy for sensitive groups", which is atypical.
