

OTHER FUNDS

This section includes five programs with five separate funding sources. The Mass Transit Capital Program (\$24,643,500 in fiscal year 2007) is supported by Federal Transit Administration grants and transit concurrency fees. The Transit Concurrency Capital Program (\$6,452,010 in 2007) is funded with transit concurrency fees. The Beach Renourishment Program (\$18,288,070 in fiscal year 2007) is supported by Federal, State, County and Municipal funds, and tourist tax. The Community Development Program (\$7,615,549 in fiscal year 2007) is funded by the Federal Community Development Block Grant and Federal Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) Grant funds, and the American Dream Downpayment Initiative grant. The Redevelopment Capital Program (\$16,417,220 in fiscal year 2007) is supported by a transfer from the General Fund.
