Issue	Subcommittees	Nature of Overlap
<b>Building Codes</b>	Greenhouse Gas Reductions (GGR) Renewable & Alternative Energy (RAES) Property and Infrastructure (BUILT)	All discussing changes to building code. GGR and BUILT overlap is specific to energy portion of Florida Building Code.
<b>Water Resources</b>	Property and Infrastructure Natural Systems Adaptation(NSA) Economic, Social, and Health (ESH) Science and Technical	Role is unclear in making recommendations related to water supply, water resources, and storm water management practices
<b>Salt Water Intrusion</b>	Science and Technical Natural Systems Adaptation Property and Infrastructure	All are talking about saltwater intrusion. Discussions are from different perspectives but may become an area of overlap.
<b>Beach</b>	Property and Infrastructure Natural Systems Adaptation	The beach as a natural resource and habitat versus the beach as a public and economic infrastructure.
<b>Emissions Mitigation</b>	Greenhouse Gas Reductions Economic, Social, and Health	ESH has listed greenhouse gas reductions measures as one focal point while this is the entire mission of the other subcommittee.
<b>Public Outreach</b>	All committees	Perception that Intergovernmental Affairs and Communication will be coordinating aspects of public outreach.
<b>Insurance</b>	Property and Infrastructure Economic, Social, and Health	Discussions brought up in both subcommittees.
<b>Reforestation</b>	Greenhouse Gas Reductions Natural Systems Adaptation	Urban landscape options are being discussed in both.
<b>Adaptation Policies and Strategies</b>	Property and Infrastructure Economic, Social, and Health	Both are considering recommendations for adaptation.
