40. SOUTH FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL – SMALL BUSINESS LOANS – COMMISSIONER LIEBERMAN

ACTION: (T-11:35 AM) Commissioner Lieberman advised that on Monday, November 7th, the South Florida Regional Planning Council approved an interlocal agreement with the State of Florida whereby Broward County businesses that were adversely impacted by Hurricane Wilma can receive grants of up to \$25,000 to help them reacquire inventory or repair physical damage to their business location. There is \$11 million available in South Florida: \$1 million for Monroe County; \$5 million for Miami-Dade County, and \$5 million for Broward County. Commissioner Lieberman briefly explained the application process to the Board. (Refer to minutes for full discussion.)

41. TREE TRIMMING IN COUNTY – POST-HURRICANE WILMA – COMMISSIONER EGELLETON

ACTION: (T-11:39 AM) Commissioner Egelleton wanted to know if the County's Tree Trimming Ordinance would be waived to expedite cleanup of fallen trees and limbs throughout the County allowing unlicensed tree trimmers to do the job. It is staff's intention that storm damaged trees and storm damaged limbs can be removed by unlicensed tree trimmers. Commissioner Egelleton commented that he felt the guidelines the County is disseminating to the public need clarification. Mayor Jacobs advised Commissioner Egelleton to bring the issue before the Board at the Hurricane Wilma workshop immediately following this day's meeting.
