### **CALL TO ORDER**

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 96-0022 to vacate and abandon a utility easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, and located south of Pines Boulevard between Southwest 184 Avenue and Southwest 196 Avenue in the city of Pembroke Pines. Petitioner: Twin Acres Partnership (Blackwell & Walker, P.A. -Agent) 35-V-95.

2. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 96-0023 to vacate and abandon a utility easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, and located in the 500 Block of Northwest 4 Street in the city of Fort Lauderdale. Petitioner: Regal Trace, Ltd. (Caulfield & Wheeler, Inc. - Agent) 3-V-96.

3. A. MOTION TO FILE proof of publication of a public hearing to receive input on the 1996 Broward County Plan Update for Complementary Paratransit Services for Persons with Disabilities.

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PLUMBING INDUSTRY; AMENDING SECTION 9-51 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES GRANTING TO THE BROWARD COUNTY CENTRAL EXAMINING BOARD OF PLUMBERS THE POWER TO REQUIRE ALL INDIVIDUALS WHO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY TO UNDERGO CONTINUING PLUMBING EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

AMENDING CHAPTER 8½ OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "CODE ENFORCEMENT," SECTION 8½-16 TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 12 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AMENDING ARTICLE II, CHAPTER 12 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "EXPLOSIVES," AMENDING SECTION 12-14 PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE AND SCOPE TO PROVIDE FOR APPLICATION WITHIN MUNICIPALITIES; AMENDING SECTION 12-38 PROVIDING FOR THE CODE AND ZONING ENFORCEMENT DIVISION TO ISSUE BLASTING PERMITS AND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR BLASTING PERMITS TO PROVIDE FOR POSTING OF SECURITY AND LIMITING THE NUMBER OF BLASTING SHOTS PER DAY; CREATING SECTION 12-42 SETTING FORTH THE ELEMENTS OF BLASTING COMPLAINTS; CREATING SECTION 12-43 ESTABLISHING HEARING OFFICERS TO HEAR BLASTING COMPLAINTS; CREATING SECTION 12-44 SETTING FORTH THE PROCEDURES BEFORE HEARING OFFICERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 26-16, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; DELETING REQUIREMENT THAT EMPLOYEES WISHING TO RUN FOR ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE TAKE LEAVE OF ABSENCE; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF RULES; MAKING SECTION GENDER-NEUTRAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
