### CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-20 to vacate and abandon rights-of-way, easements and a portion of the underlying plat lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located at 4300 SW Weston Road in unincorporated Broward County. Petitioner: The Cleveland Clinic Foundation (Keith & Schnars-Agent)

2. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-21 to vacate and abandon a right-of-way and utility easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida located south of Indian Trace Road, north of Arvida Parkway and west of Bonaventure Boulevard in unincorporated Broward County. INDEMNIFICATION; INSURANCE; PERFORMANCE BONDS; REGULATION AND INSPECTION OF CONSTRUCTION AND PERFORMANCE OF SYSTEMS; PRIORITY SERVICE AREAS; CONSUMER PROTECTION PROVISIONS; TERMINATION OF FRANCHISES; CONTINUITY OF SERVICE; PROHIBITING THEFT OF SERVICE; PROVIDING ENFORCEMENT; AMENDING SECTION RELATING TO PENALTIES; PROVIDING A GRANDPARENT PROVISION FOR CERTAIN WORK COMPLETED PRIOR TO ; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN CODE, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE I, DIVISION 2, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; SUBSTITUTING A HEARING EXAMINER FOR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO HEAR VARIANCE REQUESTS IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDING; PROVIDING FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
