

PUBLIC HEARING OF JANUARY 12, 1999

(The meeting convened at 2:00 p.m. and adjourned at 2:30 p.m.)

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was led by Caryl R. Stevens, City of Oakland Park.

CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolutions 1999-17 thru 1999-106 to assess land clearance liens.

ACTION: (B-0086) Approved.

2. MOTION TO CONSIDER amendment to lease between Broward County and Hvide Marine Incorporated due to the realignment and expansion of Eller Drive. (This is the first of two public hearings. The second public hearing will be held on Tuesday, January 26, 1999 at which time a motion for approval will be presented. The resolution setting the public hearing was adopted by the Board on December 22, 1998.)

ACTION: (B-0131) Filed proof of publication. The second public hearing will be held on Tuesday, January 26, 1999 at 2:00 p.m.

3. A. MOTION TO CONSIDER staff recommendation that a taxicab rate adjustment be granted.

ACTION: (B-0146) Denied staff's recommendation. The County will maintain its existing taxicab rates.

B. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, amending Chapter 37, Section 37.2, of the Broward County Administrative Code amending taximeter rates to be charged to the public, providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.

ACTION: (B-0146) Denied staff's recommendation. The County will maintain its existing taxicab rates.

4. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the title of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO RESOLUTIONS OF DISPUTES REGARDING THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX; AMENDING CHAPTER 31½, ARTICLE II, RELATING TO TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX TO PROVIDE FOR A METHOD OF DISPUTE RESOLUTION REGARDING TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ACTION: (B-0605) Filed proof of publication and enacted the Ordinance, as amended, to become effective as provided by law.

5. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the title of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE XII, PRIVATE AUTO TAG AGENCIES, BY AMENDING SECTION 20-247, SUBSECTION (e), TO ADDRESS EQUIPMENT PROVIDED BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES; BY AMENDING SECTION 20-251 SUBSECTION (d), TO AMEND THE PERIOD OF TIME WHEN REPORTS AND REMITTANCES SHALL BE MADE BY THE PRIVATE TAG AGENCY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ACTION: (B-0617) Filed proof of publication and enacted the Ordinance to become effective as provided by law.

6. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the title of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE XV, SECTIONS 421 THROUGH 429, "TREE ABUSE"; AND CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE XI, SECTION 342, "TREE PRESERVATION"; CREATING CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE XIV, SECTIONS 401 THROUGH 430, "BROWARD COUNTY TREE PRESERVATION AND ABUSE ORDINANCE"; PROVIDING FOR A DECLARATION OF INTENT; PROVIDING FOR APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING FOR DOCUMENTS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL PROHIBITIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE MUNICIPAL CERTIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR TREE REMOVAL LICENSE REQUIREMENTS AND STANDARDS; PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTION AND LAND CLEARING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR TREE ABUSE; PROVIDING CRITERIA FOR NATURAL FOREST COMMUNITIES; PROVIDING CRITERIA FOR HISTORICAL TREES; PROVIDING FOR THE TREE PRESERVATION TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

ACTION: (B-0627) Filed proof of publication and deferred, as amended, discussion of the ordinance for up to four (4) weeks to enable the Broward League of Cities to obtain additional information and work with the Department of Natural Resource Protection (DNRP) on the issue. Further, by way of a motion, Commissioners Parrish and Jacobs were appointed to represent the County Commission, along with county staff, on the Committee of elected officials/staff reviewing the issue.
