1. **MOTION TO ADOPT** 2001 Broward County State Legislative Program.

2. **MOTION TO CONSIDER** marine terminal management agreement between Broward County and South Stevedoring, Inc., as the new terminal operator for the terminated leasehold premises of Seaboard Marine, Ltd. (This is the first of two Public Hearings. The second Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, February 13, 2001 at 2:00 p.m.)

3. A. **MOTION TO CONSIDER** enactment of an ordinance, the title of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BROWARD COUNTY TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES USING BROWARD COUNTY-OWNED RIGHTS-OF-WAY TO REGISTER AND TO PAY OCCUPANCY FEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

B. **MOTION TO ADOPT** Resolution Amending Part V, Chapter 35 of the Broward County Administrative Code relating to fees for use of the County's rights-of-way for construction, maintenance, repair, installation, and operation of cable television, open video systems, telecommunications facilities, and private communications systems; providing for registration fees for operators of telecommunications facilities and owners of private communications systems; providing for a fee to be established for the privilege of using the public rights-of-way for construction, maintenance, repair, installation, and operation of telecommunication facilities and private communications systems.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES BY REZONING A PORTION OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 49 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; FROM RM-10, MULTIPLE-FAMILY DWELLING DISTRICT TO RD-10, DUPLEX AND ATTACHED ONE-FAMILY DWELLING DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING DISTRICT MAPS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL REZONING ORDINANCES AND ZONING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT THIS REZONING SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CREATE A RIGHT TO DEVELOPMENT THAT FAILS TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF OTHER LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
