

PUBLIC HEARING OF FEBRUARY 28, 2006

CALL TO ORDER

1. **MOTION TO ADOPT** Resolution 2006-066 to vacate and abandon a 30-foot Road Right-of-Way, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, and being a portion of SW 12th Avenue between Dania Beach Boulevard and SW 1st Street in the City of Dania Beach, Florida, at no cost to the County. Petitioner: Albert and Madeline Marco; Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. – Agent (2005-V-01) **(Commission District 7)**

2. **MOTION TO ADOPT** Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, granting renewal of a non-exclusive franchise to ISS Marine Services, Inc., for a five-year term, to provide steamship agent services at Port Everglades, providing for severability; providing for an effective date; and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute the franchise. The Resolution setting this Public Hearing was adopted on February 7, 2006 (Item 29).
