

# PUBLIC HEARING OF FEBRUARY 28, 1995

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ENDORSE the general concepts within the attached memorandum regarding the State Road 7/Gateway 7 area and direct staff to pursue the following:

A. Preparation of the necessary documents to allow utilization by the abutting business property owners of up to 40 feet of the 50 foot drainage easement located east of State Road 7 within Melrose Park.

ACTION: (B-137) The Board suggested that meetings be held with the residents of the subject areas to address the issue further.

B. Preparation of the final plans, specifications and cost estimates for a landscaped buffer between the State Road 7 businesses and the adjoining Melrose Park residential area and other neighborhood tree plantings.

ACTION: (B-137) Denied.

C. Investigation of the use of the Tree Trust Fund for tree plantings along neighborhood streets within the Melrose Park, Broward Estates and St. George neighborhoods.

ACTION: (B-137) Approved.

D. Preparation of budget actions and schedules for county participation in the Melrose Park drainage improvements.

ACTION: (B-137) Approved.

E. Continuation of the neighborhood participation process of review and comments on the State Road 7 expansion project/Gateway 7 project.

ACTION: (B-137) As the past neighborhood participation process by the city of Plantation was insufficient, the Board suggested that it be continued.

F. Preparation of engineering and design work necessary to complete the filling and piping of the Melrose Park perimeter ditch and the Broward Estates/St. George Northwest 35 Avenue ditch by December 1998.

ACTION: (B-137) The Board suggested that meetings be held with the residents of the subject areas to address the issue further.
