SECTION 27-41, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; ALLOWING FOR THE PAYMENT OF MONETARY REWARDS FROM THE POLLUTION PREVENTION AND RECOVERY FUND TO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC WHOSE REPORTING OF ENVIRONMENTAL CRIMES OR POLLUTION INCIDENTS TO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION RESULTS IN THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF CIVIL PENALTIES FROM SAID VIOLATORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE COURTS, LEGAL SERVICES, AND A JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE SEVENTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT THAT ESTABLISHES A FEE FOR THE DEFERRAL OF PAYMENT OF FINES OR COURT COSTS OR BOTH IN COUNTY COURT; PROVIDING FOR ENDORSEMENT OF THE JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THROUGH ITS ORDINANCE ENACTMENT POWERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
