

PUBLIC HEARING OF APRIL 25, 2006

(The meeting convened at 2:00 p.m. and adjourned at 3:32 p.m.)

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was led by Marcelo Bezos, who is attempting to break one of the Guinness Book of World Records by becoming the person who has created the tallest coin column in recorded history.

CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 2006-299 of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, granting a non-exclusive franchise to Raider Environmental Services, LLC, for a one-year term, to provide vessel sanitary waste water removal services at Port Everglades, providing for severability; providing for an effective date; and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute the franchise. The Resolution setting this Public Hearing was adopted on March 28, 2006 (Item 46).

ACTION: (T-2:42 PM) The Board granted a non-exclusive franchise to Raider Environmental Services, LLC, for a period of two weeks, until such time as the next Public Hearing on Tuesday, May 9, 2006. Prior to returning before the Board for consideration of a one-year term, information shall be submitted which would clarify the issues that have been identified by the County Commission this day; namely: 1) The relationship between the applicant, Raider Environmental Services, LLC; Raider Environmental Services, Inc. and Raider Rooter, the firm owned by his parents, where the applicant was the qualifying agent. 2) What the Notices of Violation (NOV) are. 3) Which company do the NOV's refer to, and whether or not those NOV's occurred during the time frame the applicant was a qualifying agent for his parent's firm, Raider Rooter, and if his license had any ties to the violations. 2. MOTION TO CONSIDER award of a new license for the provision of non-emergency medical transportation services (NEMTS) to South Florida's Global Transportation and Ponder & Associates, Inc. d/b/a Tender Loving Care Adult Day Health Center, contingent upon completion of requirements identified in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.
