I. A. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 91-0965 authorizing exchange of county property for property owned by MAP Builders, Inc., as provided in Section 125.37 of the Florida Statutes; and authorize the Chair and the Clerk to execute a Quitclaim Deed from the County.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CREATING DIVISION 4 OF CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE VII, OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE; REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR SHOPS; PROVIDING FOR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR TECHNICIANS; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Further, as stipulated in the ordinance, a Motor Vehicle Repair Industry Board will be established for administrative purposes consisting of seven members appointed by the Commission. Five members shall be persons from the motor vehicle repair industry and shall be ASE certified in all eight specialties. The Commissioners who will make these five appointments are: Commissioner Parrish who appointed John Fore; Commissioner Grossman; Commissioner Poitier; Commissioner Hart and Commissioner Thompson. The remaining two persons shall not be connected with the motor vehicle repair industry. The Commissioners who will make these two appointments are Commissioner Cowan and Commissioner Kennedy.

B. MOTION to adopt Resolution 91-0967 amending Chapter 37, Part I, Consumer Affairs described as follows:
