CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 95-489 to vacate and abandon a utility easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located at the southeast corner of Stirling Road and Holatee Trail in unincorporated Broward County. Petitioner: Kenneth Wolter (Jan C. Hansen - Agent) 31-V-93.

ACTION: (B-52) Approved.

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 95-490 to vacate and abandon road right-of-way, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located at 2511 NW 6th Street in unincorporated Broward County. Petitioner: Mark Adams (Pulice Land Surveyors, Inc. - Agent) 16-V-95.

ACTION: (B-57) Approved.

2. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 95-491 to vacate and abandon road right-of-way, lying and being in Broward County, located between SW 31 Avenue and S.R. 7 south of Griffin Road in the City of Hollywood. Petitioner: VST/VMIF Oakridge Partnership (Berry & Calvin, Inc. - Agent) 3-V-94.

3. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 95-492 to vacate and abandon rights-of-way and utility easements, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, and located west of State Road 7, south of NW 59 Avenue and north of NW 57 Terrace in the City of Margate. Petitioner: Great Horizons Development Corp. (Craig Smith & Assoc. - Agent) 13-V-95.

4. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolutions 95-493 through 95-569 to assess land clearance liens.

MOTION TO APPROVE a twenty-year lease agreement between Broward County, Florida and Tecmarine Lines, Inc. for 13.12 acres of land and Building 28 at Port Everglades, and authorize the Chair and Clerk to execute same. (This is the second of two public hearings. The first was held on Tuesday, May 9, 1995 at 2:00 p.m.)

MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 95-570 of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, granting a non-exclusive franchise to Starfleet, Inc. for time period certain; to perform vessel bunkering services at Port Everglades; providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 16½, ARTICLES I, II, AND III OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE BROWARD COUNTY HUMAN RIGHTS ACT; AMENDING PARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 16½-2(1), RELATING TO PURPOSES AND CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING FOR FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION BASED UPON SEXUAL ORIENTATION; AMENDING SECTION 16½-3, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS; INCLUDING SEXUAL ORIENTATION WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF DISCRIMINATORY CLASSIFICATION; DEFINING SEXUAL ORIENTATION; RENUMBERING CERTAIN SUBSECTIONS; AMENDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF SUBSECTION (f) AND SUBSECTION (g) OF SECTION 16½-21, RELATING TO DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT; AMENDING SUBSECTIONS (3), (4), AND (5) OF SECTION 16½-21.1, RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES; AMENDING 16½-22, RELATING TO DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS; AMENDING SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 16½-24, RELATING TO INTERFERENCE, COERCION OR INTIMIDATION; AMENDING SUBSECTION (3) OF SECTION 16½-26, RELATING TO BLOCKBUSTING; AMENDING SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 16½-30, RELATING TO FURTHER EXCEPTIONS; AMENDING SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 16½-61, RELATING TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD; AMENDING SECTION 16½-73, RELATING TO CONFIDENTIALITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
