5:15 P.M. PUBLIC HEARING

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY AMENDING CHAPTER 5, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY CREATING ARTICLE XVII, PRESERVATION OF HISTORICAL CULTURAL RESOURCE SITES; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS REGARDING PROTECTION OF HISTORICAL CULTURAL RESOURCE SITES; PROVIDING FOR SCOPE AND EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES FOR DESIGNATION OF HISTORICAL CULTURAL RESOURCE SITES; PROHIBITING THE ALTERATION OR DEMOLITION OF AN HISTORICAL CULTURAL RESOURCE SITE UNTIL A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS IS OBTAINED FROM THE LOCAL HISTORICAL COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR MAINTENANCE OF HISTORICAL CULTURAL RESOURCE SITES; PROVIDING FOR A RIGHT OF APPEAL; PROVIDING THAT VIOLATIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE CONSIDERED A PUBLIC NUISANCE; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE." (92-448)

RELATING TO TURNAROUNDS ON CUL-DE-SACS TO COMPLY WITH THE SOUTH FLORIDA BUILDING CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE." (93-403)
