

**PUBLIC HEARING OF AUGUST 9, 1994**

(The meeting convened at 2 p.m. and adjourned at 3 p.m.)

CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-886 to vacate and abandon utility easements lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located in the S.E. quadrant of the intersection of Southgate Blvd. and the Sawgrass Expressway in the City of Tamarac. Petitioner: Pulte Home Corp. (CCL Consultants - Agent) 24-V-94.

ACTION: (A-5075A) Approved.

2. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-887 to vacate and abandon utility easements lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located in the N.E. quadrant of the intersection of the Sawgrass Expressway and McNab Road in the City of Tamarac. Petitioner: Pulte Home Corp. (CCL Consultants - Agent) 27-V-94.

ACTION: (A-5083A) Approved.

3. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-888 to vacate and abandon road right-of-way, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located on Cleveland Street west of State Road 7 in the City of Hollywood. Petitioner: Hollywood Imports Ltd., Inc. (Susan P. Motley, Esq. - Agent) 7-V-94.

4. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolutions 94-889 & 94-890 to assess land clearance liens upon certain described lands in accordance with settlement agreements.

5. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolutions 94-891 thru 94-935 to assess land clearance liens.

ACTION: (A-5120A) Approved.

6. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the substance of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SPECIFIED NON-PROFIT AND GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS; MAKING A FINDING AND DETERMINATION THAT THE WORK AND SERVICES OF THE ORGANIZATIONS SERVE A PUBLIC PURPOSE; AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR THE ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994-1995; PRESCRIBING REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS FOR DISBURSEMENT OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ACTION: (A-5128A) Public Hearing continued to Tuesday, August 16, 1994, at 10 a.m.

7. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the substance of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; CREATING THE BROWARD COUNTY HOMELESS INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

ACTION: (A-5156A) Filed proof of publication and enacted Ordinance, as amended, to be effective as provided by law. County Attorney's Office to draft language for clarification of the disbursement of funds if the Trust Fund were to be abolished.

8. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the substance of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AMENDING CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-557 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE," PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ACTION: (A-5739A) Filed proof of publication and enacted Ordinance to be effective as provided by law.

9. A. MOTION TO FILE proof of publication of a public hearing to consider whether the issuance of 11 additional taxicab permits should be authorized.

ACTION: (A-5769A) Approved.

B. MOTION TO FILE proof of publication of a public hearing to consider whether the issuance of 5 additional limousine permits should be authorized.

ACTION: (A-5769A) Approved.

C. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 94-936 directing the County Administrator to publish notice of public hearing for Tuesday, October 11, 1994 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 422 of the Broward County Governmental Center for the purpose of holding a drawing to award new taxicab and/or limousine permits to applicants.

ACTION: (A-5769A) Approved.

10. MOTION TO FILE proof of publication of a public hearing to consider adoption of experimental improvements and changes in route schedules that were implemented on May 8, 1994, and to consider implementing service changes for selected routes of the Broward County Mass Transit System.

ACTION: (A-5798A) Approved.

11. MOTION TO CONSIDER enactment of an ordinance, the substance of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; ASSESSING A SURCHARGE OF \$12.50 FOR EACH MOVING TRAFFIC VIOLATION PROVIDED UNDER THE STATE UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL LAW; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF SAID SURCHARGES BY THE BROWARD COUNTY CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT; PROVIDING THAT THE FUNDS GENERATED BY SAID SURCHARGE SHALL BE USED TO FUND BROWARD COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RADIO COMMUNICATION PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE DIVISION OF COMMUNICATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES; PROVIDING

FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

ACTION: (A-1040B) Filed proof of publication and enacted Ordinance to become effective on January 1, 1995.

In a related discussion, County Commission directed the County Attorney's Office to research the possibility of a surcharge for disabled persons who park in handicapped parking spaces and do not display their handicapped permits. The issue of photo identification of handicapped permits was referred to Julie Shaw, Chair, Advisory Board for Persons with Disabilities. In addition, the County Commission, through the Chair, will forward a letter to Chief Judge Dale Ross requesting that court costs be imposed by the Traffic Magistrates for disabled persons who do not properly display handicapped permits when parking in a handicapped parking space.
