1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 92-1381 to vacate and abandon utility easements, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located in the northwest quadrant of the intersection of Sheridan Street and Palm Avenue in Cooper City; Petitioner: K. Hovnanian Companies (Berry & Calvin, Inc., Agent) 17-V-92.

ACTION: (A-113) (2:08 p.m.) Approved.

2. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 92-1382 to vacate and abandon a lake maintenance easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located south of West Broward Boulevard and north of State Road 84 in the city of Plantation; Petitioner: Robert D. Lettman and Andrea B. Lettman 19-V-92.

3. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 92-1383 to vacate and abandon a utility easement, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, located west of and adjacent to Northwest 27 Avenue between Sunrise Boulevard and Oakland Park Boulevard in unincorporated Broward County; Petitioner: Reliance Church of God Inc. (James D. Stoner & Associates, Agent) 25-V-92.

4. MOTION TO CONSIDER the award or denial of a license (new) to provide Nonemergency Medical Transportation Services (NEMTS) to Tri-South Transportation Services Inc. and Medi-Wheels Systems I Inc.

ACTION: (A-134) (2:09 p.m.) Approved staff's recommendation: Awarded license (new) to provide NEMTS to Tri-South Transportation Services Inc.; and denied license (new) to provide NEMTS to Medi-Wheels Systems I Inc. based on the recommendation of the Review Committee of the Broward Regional EMS Council, and a finding by the County Commission that the applicant failed to meet the required criteria, as well as past practices involving insurance. Commissioner Parrish requested that administration have appropriate staff ascertain if Medi- Wheels is transporting patients in violation of the code and report back to the Board on the results of its investigation.

5. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolutions 92-1384 through 92-1403 to assess land clearance liens.

ACTION: (A-438, Tape 92-114 & A-135, Tape 92-115) (2:19 p.m., Tape 92-114 & 5:20 p.m., Tape 92-115) Approved, as amended: Delete Invoice No. 920198 in the amount of \$305.25 for Miami Gardens Estates, Lot 43, Block 26, as the assessment was paid, and Invoice No. 920196 in the amount of \$7,674.85 which is to be voted on by separate motion. By unanimous consent the Board directed staff to review the file on Invoice No. 920196 and report back to the Board at the 5:15 p.m. public hearing today; at the 5:15 p.m. public hearing the Board adopted a resolution assessing a lien in the amount of

\$7,674.85, but should the property owner agree to advise the county within 10 days how same chooses to satisfy the lien, said lien is to be reduced to \$3,285 per staff's recommendation.
