

PUBLIC HEARING OF OCTOBER 24, 2006

CALL TO ORDER

1. MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution 2006-786 of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, granting renewal of a non-exclusive franchise to V. Ships Agency, Inc., for a five-year term to provide steamship agent services at Port Everglades, providing for severability; providing for an effective date; and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute the franchise. The Resolution setting this Public Hearing was adopted on October 10, 2006 (Item 35).

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AMENDING SUBSECTION 5-182(a)(5)b) RELATING TO REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION CONCURRENCY WITHIN STANDARD CONCURRENCY DISTRICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
