



INTRASTATE MOVES

Effective July 1, 2002, Chapter 507, Florida Statutes requires any person engaged in intrastate moving to register annually with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Consumer Services. This includes any person who transports or ships household goods for compensation that originates and terminates within the State of Florida. Registration with the Department is required if you are an intrastate mover, regardless of any other local, municipal or county licensing requirements. However, you should note state registration does not exempt you from obtaining a local, municipal or county license. Failure to comply with this law may subject you to a cease and desist order and fines of up to \$5,000.
