MINIMAL INTAKE REQUIREMENTS FOR WASTEWATER PROJECT SUBMITTALS

- Two (2) original Broward County EPD Application Form 212-0004 are required.
 - Original signatures and seal on Page 4 of all copies.

- The front page of the County Application must be complete for accurate input into the county and state database. Typical items missing:
 - The applicant's name and title (clear and readable)
 - Project location including boundaries of larger projects and/or address
 - An address for lift stations required (derived is acceptable for application)
 - Zip code
 - Section, Township and Range
 - Plat Description
 - Flow Calculations

- An 8 ½" x 11" site plan must be attached delineating an accurate location of the project area.

- A check payable to the "Broward County Board of County Commissioners".
 - The check's total should match the fee calculations on Page 3 of the County application, line 7. (Rev. October 22, 2004)

- One (1) original Florida DEP Form 62-604.300(a) must be submitted.
 - Original signatures Page 10
 - Original signatures and seal Page 11

- One (1) set of signed, sealed and dated plans must be submitted, along with any other specifications the Engineer deems necessary to show the scope of the project. See Page 2 of the County Application form.

Failure to comply with the above six (6) requirements with complete and accurate information in the Project Submittal Package may result in a delay or the return of the submittal to the Engineer of Record.
