4-H entries open to all youth officially enrolled in Broward County 4-H. For more information, contact the 4-H office at 4-H@broward.org or by phone at 954-370-3725.

Rules:

1. No Entry Fee.
2. Use official 4-H Fair Entry Tag. Affix entry tag to entry.
3. Entry tag may not be photocopied and must be filled in completely or entry will be disqualified.
4. Posters may only be entered in Class 10 and should be no less than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 22".
5. Members may enter one (1) item per Sub-Class and no more than five (5) entries.
6. 4-Hers need to present each item to judges and be prepared for questions. Only Cloverbuds may be accompanied by a parent.
7. Judging will be done in 16 different Classes with Best of Show awarded in three age levels: Junior (8-10), Intermediate (11-13), and Senior (14-18).

Classifications:

Class I – Agriculture

Sub-Class 1 – Flowers

One exhibit is three (3) specimens of annual or perennial flowers grown around the home.

Sub-Class 2 – Fruits

Any tropical fruit grown as part of a 4-H Project

Sub-Class 3 – Horticulture

Includes Dish Gardens, Hanging Baskets, Potted Plants, Terrariums, Corsage (3 or more fresh blooms)

Sub-Class 4 – Vegetables

One exhibit is three (3) specimens of any vegetable grown as part of the 4-H Garden Project. Example: 3 Tomatoes

Class II – Animal Science-Related Items

Sub-Class 1 – Pets, Farm Animals, and Companion Animals

Sub-Class 2 – Items made for the care of an animal

Class III – Entomology

Sub-Class 1 – Entomology

Insect collection including Riker Mounts

Sub-Class 2 – Beekeeping

Class IV – Clothing

Sub-Class 1 – Clothing (level 1 & 2) Limited to 4-hers enrolled in Clothing project 1 & 2.

Any simple garment completed in Clothing 1 & 2 project.

Examples: apron, t-top, easy wrap skirt, poncho, etc. Garments with zippers are not included in this Class.

Sub-Class 2 – Clothing (Intermediate & Advanced)

Open to all 4-Hers enrolled in Clothing 3.

Garments with zippers are included in this Class.

Sub-Class 3 – Clothing Accessories

Accessory (tie, scarf, purse, etc.) Remade/remodeled garment – describe the original garment & what you did to it

Class V – Food

All food entries must have a recipe neatly typed and securely attached to the entry tag and food item. A food item can only be entered in one Class. The Class designation is decided by the recipe itself. What ingredient is there most of? (Note: Similar ingredients such as ½ cup apples and ½ cup grapes would be considered 1 cup fruit.) All food entries become the property of the 4-H and will not be returned. Entries must be submitted in disposable containers.

Sub-Class 1 – Baked Items includes breads, rolls, cookies, muffins, cake, pretzels

Sub-Class 2 – Rice & Pasta – Hot & Cold Rice and Pasta dishes

Sub-Class 3 – Dairy Foods – At least 1 cup of mil, cheese, yogurt or ice cream.

Sub-Class 4 – Desserts Non-Baked

Sub-Class 5 – Fruit or Vegetable Dishes

Sub-Class 6 – Meat, Poultry, Fish, Dry Beans, Eggs and Nut Groups

Sub-Class 7 – Low-Fat Food includes jams, jellies and other canned products

Sub-Class 8 – BBQ Sauce (one-pint jar) – For members who have completed 4-H Poultry BBQ and/or Outdoor Cookery Record Book.

Class VI – Environmental

Sub-Class 1 – Conservation & Ecology

Pertaining to world conservation & ecology efforts such as stopping destruction of rain forest, recycling, toxic waste, etc.

Sub Class 2 – Marine Science

Any exhibit or display concerning saltwater estuarine or beach ecology

Sub-Class 3 – Wildlife, Wetlands & Forestry

Projects pertaining to terrestrial environments, including birds and other wild animals.

Class VII – Handicraft – Recreation

Articles or displays made can be from Recreation Project 1, 2 & 3.

Sub-Class 1 – Arts & Crafts

Paper Mache, leather craft, macramé, etc. Decorated items sewn by hand or machine, intended for display in home. Ex. pillows, curtains, holiday decorations.

Sub-Class 2 – Sewing Non-Clothing

Items sewn but not intended for clothing, accessories or home decoration (ex. horse blanket)

Class VIII – Fine Art

Sub-Class 1 – Drawing, Painting & Sketching.

Class IX – Hobbies – Recreation

Sub-Class 1 – Rock & Stamp Collection, etc.

Sub-Class 2 – Fly tying, model building, etc.

Class X – FPL Posters, Sponsored by the generosity of Florida Power and Light

Name, address & age should be on the back

Must be a minimum of 8.5" x 11" and maximum of 14" x 22".

Sub-Class 1 – 4-H Posters (size 14" x 22")

Sub-Class 2 – Demonstration Poster showing progression of ongoing projects

Sub-Class 3 – Energy Conservation and Green Technologies

Class XI – General

Sub-Class 1 – Citizenship – Pertaining to Community Service. Any item or display that illustrates carrying out Citizenship responsibilities.

Sub-Class 2 – Careers – Any item related to the exploration of jobs.

Class XII – Health & Home Economics

Sub-Class 1 – Special entries and displays for Health & Happiness and winning Smiles Projects.

Sub-Class 2 – Safety – Special entries and displays for Safety & Seat Belt Safety Projects.

Sub-Class 3 Home Economics and Home Management Exhibits & Displays. No Food or Clothing in this class. Also includes exhibits from Child Development and Consumer Education Projects.

Class XIII – Industrial Arts

Sub-Class 1 – Aerospace & Rocketry – Any article or display made in aerospace or rocketry project.

Sub-Class 2 – Electric Energy – Any article or display made in the electric & energy project.

Sub-Class 3 – Woodworking – Any article or display made in the woodworking project.

Class XIV – Computers

Sub-Class 1 – Any article made in the computer project.

Class XV – Photography

Sub-Class 1 – Photography – 5" x 7" or 8" x 10" photos taken by 4-Her as part of photography project. Photo must be mounted on poster board or mat board or frame. **No Loose Photos.**

Sub-Class 2 – Photo Montage – Montage of photos taken by 4-Her as part of photography project. Maximum size 16"x 20".

Class XVI – Club Entries – Items where entire club is involved (ex. sign, quilt, community pride, Club Safety Project, Club Banner). One (1) item per sub-class.

Sub-Class 1 – Club Projects – Any item the club worked on as a club project.

4-H FAIR PROJECT EXHIBIT AWARDS:

Blue Ribbon - \$3

Red Ribbon - \$2

White Ribbon - \$1

Best of Show - \$15 (One class & age division, if judges deem appropriate.)

Cloverbuds will receive \$1 participation award per project up to 5 projects.

Prizes will be the same for individual and club entries.
