On Tuesday, March 13, 2007, an unfamiliar face will be sitting on the dais in the Broward County Commission Chamber. Mylah Bryant-Robinson will join the Broward County Commission as the “shadow” guest of Commissioner Kristin Jacobs. Bryant-Robinson, a fourteen-year-old ninth grader at Deerfield Beach High School, will accompany Commissioner Jacobs through a typical Commission day, attending meetings and getting a first hand view of the inner workings of Broward County Government.

“Ms. Bryant-Robinson is a bright young lady who has a keen interest in developing community leadership skills,” said Commissioner Jacobs. “I’m pleased to give her the opportunity to experience one day in the life of a political leader as she moves forward in her career. She’ll have a front row seat to the actions and processes that affect the lives of Broward County residents everyday.”

Bryant-Robinson has been selected to participate in this year’s National Young Leaders Conference in Washington D.C. The National Young Leader’s Conference, organized by the Congressional Youth Leadership Council, is designed to instruct and enrich promising students in a hands-on, experiential atmosphere while preparing them for a lifetime of leadership.

Bryant-Robinson’s high academic achievements and leadership abilities placed her as one of this year’s outstanding high school students from across the United States. She is also a distinguished alumni member of the Congressional Youth Leadership Council at Parkway Middle School.

Broward County Commission meetings are held at the Broward County Governmental Center, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Room 422 in Fort Lauderdale and begin at 10:00 a.m. Ms. Bryant-Robinson will begin the day with Commissioner Jacobs at 9:00 a.m.
