**Broward County Commission Libraries Division Announces  
New E-Invitation for the Miramar Library and Education Center**

BROWARD COUNTY, FL – Broward County Library recently expanded its E-Communication to include E-Invitations, electronic communication that provides information about new library locations. Signing up for the service is quick and easy -- a person can sign up online with their name and an e-mail address. Periodic construction updates as well as an electronic invitation to the grand-opening ceremony of the new library are then provided via e-mail.

The E-Invitation is currently available for the new Miramar Library and Education Center being constructed in the Miramar Town Center. April's electronic communication includes an aerial view of the building, showing the substantial construction that has already taken place, as well as a sneak preview of the public art in creation for the new library. Features of the new library are also listed.

The E-Invitation was first used for the new West Regional Library, which opened in October 2007. In just three months, more than 1,400 people signed up for the service to receive construction updates and a grand-opening invitation via e-mail.
