**StoryBook Festival at Southwest Regional Library on Saturday, November 17**

BROWARD COUNTY, FL – Children’s stories come alive at Broward County Library’s StoryBook Festival from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on November 17 at the Southwest Regional Library, 16835 Sheridan Street in Pembroke Pines.

The free family event will feature performances on three stages, fairy-tale crafts, strolling storybook characters and the Miami Herald’s Fantasy Forest, where children can interact with fairy-tale friends. The first 1,200 children at the festival will receive a free book. Performances will include: *The Hundred Dresses*, by Eckerd Theater Company, based on the book by Eleanor Estes; celebrated storyteller Windell Campbell; *Little Red Riding Hood*, a musical adaptation by Superstar Productions; and Sweet Stories with Nanny Gingerbread, featuring *The Gingerbread Man* and *Hansel and Gretel*.

Attendees are encouraged to bring cameras for the StoryBook Photo Spots, where photographs of fairy-tale “cut-outs” will turn youngsters into Mary Poppins, Willy Wonka and other favorite characters.

The StoryBook Festival is funded by the Broward Public Library Foundation with support from *The Miami Herald*, the City of Pembroke Pines, Comcast, *Broward Family Life Magazine* and Friends of Southwest Regional Library.
