She also cautions that the list is subjective and that individuals should use their own personal judgment.

We encourage the use of the **Five Finger Rule** in determining reading level appropriateness. We also encourage parents to select a variety of materials that will include some that are "just right" based on the Five Finger Rule as well as some that might be "too easy" and some that might be "too hard." This variety will challenge a reader to continue to improve reading skills while preserving a love of reading.

When selecting materials for your child, always select materials that appeal to the child's interest.
