Item # 2 Training Initiatives System's Meeting Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ 101 Wraparound training was cancelled due to attendance. ❖ Broward Model: Joanne Kent from Smith Community Mental Health discussed the Broward Model training that is funded through CSAD. The training is designed to work in compatibility with Wraparound. The training teaches therapist specifically how to work in the Wraparound system of care. The fifteen hours of training is being filmed. ❖ Wraparound: Members discussed changing the title of Wraparound to emphasis System of Care values. ❖ Silvia- Wraparound trainings are not a requirement of contracts. ❖ Joanne- The 101 Wraparound trainings are for three days. Providers would be more apt to send new hires if it was user friendly by decreasing the duration of the training to one day instead of three. ❖ Shari- 101 is mandated for targeted case managers. It's a Medicaid requirement. System of Care will help any provider no matter what model they're using. ❖ Joel- Posted the question whether Wraparound is truly embedded in Broward County. ❖ Joel- Wraparound is being supported for the "deep end kids" only. How does one define a "deep end kid"? 	101 training was cancelled due to lack of attendance. The trainings are being offered to Starting Place and Memorial however they are not participating. Shari stated her new hires at Henderson Mental Health Center are doing individualized trainings with coaching from David Duresky. Members will further discuss the topics of concern with Wraparound at the next meeting. .Joel asked Silvia to please email him Memorial's contact person's information.

They're reviewing plans and doing individual coaching with the staff. ❖ Memorial has not been attending meetings or trainings. ❖ Wraparound 101Training: The School Board suggested scheduling the trainings in the mornings. There schedules are not flexible which it's hard to attend three day training. At the last 101 wraparound training attended by School Board personnel there was confusion about the certification process. ❖ Communication will be enhanced to highlight that the 101 training marks the beginning of certification. ❖ Next Wraparound 101is scheduled for August. 	Joel suggested planning a meeting with the four area coordinators to discuss the concept of how they can become certified and who should continue to the next level to become a facilitator.

The focus is mental health and it's sponsored by CSC. ❖ Members discussed having the meeting at Smith Community Health Center then drive to The Youth Resource Center at the Boys and Girls Club for a tour.
