PORTIONS OF MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL AT QUIET WATERS PARK REOPEN *- Phase I of a projected five-mile revamped trail -*

WHAT: Quiet Waters Park in Deerfield Beach announces the **COMPLETION OF PHASE I OF THE PARK'S MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL**, to reopen to the public on Saturday, April 5. Under the direction of the International Mountain Bike Association, local riders have volunteered more than 1,200 hours to remove debris, reshape the land, install new plants, and construct the new trail. Phase I consists of 2.67 miles of novice and intermediate loops. The final trail, expected to be completed in summer 2008, will stretch five miles.

Trail-building days are from 8:30 a.m. to noon on the second and fourth Saturdays of the month. Volunteers who would like to work on and maintain the trails should visit the park office or call Eddie Garczyk at 954-360-1315, ext. 226 for more information.
