Deerfield Beach employees and officials take a great deal of pride in the city's comprehensive and extensive recycling efforts – and it shows in the tremendous success of their program.

The city's environmental achievements include:

- Provided weekly residential yard-waste collection.
- Spearheaded weekly collection of mixed paper and full service commercial recycling including office paper.
- Received Green Seal Award for purchasing recycled sanitary paper products.
- Purchased reflective vests made from recycled materials for Broward Sheriff's Office crossing guards.
- Provided education and free compost bins for residents.
- Created imaginative collection sites for plastic bottles and aluminum cans including a five-foot tall "cola bottle" collection bin at convenience stores and other various "away from the home" sites.
- Established the only city special waste drop-off center in Broward County.
