In 1999, Hollywood Woodwork began the transition from a family-owned business to an employee-owned organization through an Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP).

Their environmental accomplishments include:

- Implemented the Lean Manufacturing Concept
- Partnered with the Florida Manufacturing Extension Partnership to help enact culture change with employees. Continuous education features waste reduction
- Improved coating methods with HVLP airless equipment
- Trained employees in use of new equipment
- Changed from solvent based to water based primer
- Use HAP's compliant coatings when possible
- These changes resulted in 30.5% reduction in coating material use
- 55% VOC reduction
- 50% HAP reduction
