

# **LIVING WAGE ADVISORY BOARD**

**Purpose:** Review the implementation and effectiveness of the Broward County Living Wage Ordinance and advise the Board of County Commissioners of the same, together with any recommendations for amendments hereto.

**Created by:** Broward County Ordinance #2002-45, enacted October 8, 2002, effective October 1, 2003.

**Membership:** Nine (9) members appointed by the Broward County Commission:

Each member of the Broward County Commission shall appoint one (1) member provided that no more than (4) members are representatives of the business community.

No representatives of entities contracting with Broward County or Broward County employees shall be members of the Board.

**Terms:** Section 1-233 of Chapter 1, Article XII, Broward County Code of Ordinances, as amended.

- (1) Serve at the pleasure of the nominating commissioner or the other appointing authority where appropriate; or
- (2) Serve until the nominating commissioner vacates his or her office for any reason.

**Quorum:** Fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the total appointed board members.
