

RESOURCE RECOVERY BOARD

Purpose: Serve as the governing board of the Broward County Solid Waste Disposal District to construct, operate, maintain, and repair the resource recovery system for the disposal of solid waste generated in the district and the recovery and sale of materials and energy therefrom, including all landfills, transfer stations, disposal facilities and electric generating facilities.

Created by: Interlocal Agreement, dated November 26, 1986, among and between Broward County and twenty-five (25) municipalities (Contract Communities), for Solid Waste Disposal Services and oversight through the Resource Recovery Board serving as the governing board.

Broward County Ordinance #87-3, pursuant to Section 125.01(1), Florida Statutes, enacted March 10, 1987, creating a special district known as the Broward Solid Waste Disposal District; providing for its governance by the Resource Recovery Board (RRB).

Amended by Resolution #2003-313, adopted April 29, 2003, providing that if any County Commissioner appointed to the RRB is unable to attend a scheduled meeting of the RRB, such Commissioner may be temporarily replaced by a substitute County Commissioner.

Tenth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement, dated April 15, 2006, approved August 22, 2006; effective April 2007, changes the composition of the membership to reflect the smaller portion of unincorporated area in the County. The County Commission members are reduced from 4 to 1; the Contract Communities members are increased from 3 to 6, the Broward League of Cities members are increased from 1 to 2; and the 1 alternating member position was eliminated.

Membership: Nine (9) members.

(1) One (1) member of and appointed by the Broward County Commission.

(2) Six (6) members shall be appointed by the Contract Communities as follows:

One member shall be selected by the 3 contract communities with the largest populations.

One member shall be selected by the 3 contract communities nearest to the median in size based upon population.

- (3) Two (2) members shall be chosen by the highest ranking office of the Broward League of Cities, held by an elected official from a municipal contract community..

Each member of the Resource Recovery Board shall be an elected official. Vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term.

All members shall be elected officials of their respective contract community or county commission.

A County Commissioner appointed to the RRB who is unable to attend a scheduled meeting of the RRB shall advise the Mayor and the Executive Director of the RRB in writing of his or her unavailability at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to a scheduled RRB meeting and the Mayor shall designate a temporary replacement County Commissioner at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the RRB meeting.

For the purpose of this section, population figures contained in the latest estimate of population published by the University of Florida Bureau of Economic and Business shall be used.

- Terms: Two (2) years.
- Quorum: A majority of the members of the board.
