

AIRPORT TASK FORCE

Purpose: To review and provide constructive comment to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, with the cooperation and assistance of the County Administrator, regarding the impact of the 2020 Vision projects and certain other long-term Airport development on the community..

Created by: Broward County Resolution #2002-277, approved March 19, 2002.

On April 9, 2002, the Board approved additional guidelines to clarify the purpose of the Airport Task Force; and modified the membership of the task force by adding a representative of the Town of Davie.

Amended by Resolution #2003-297, approved April 8, 2003, modifying the membership by adding a representative from the City of Plantation; providing that county staff sit as a non-voting member of the task force.

On October 12, 2004, the Board approved the requirement that the representative of a homeowners association in the City of Fort Lauderdale be a member and resident of the Edgewood Homeowners Association.

Membership: Fourteen (14) members.

- (1) A member of the Board of County Commissioners, who shall serve as Chair.
- (2) Five (5) representatives (one each) from the following municipalities: Fort Lauderdale, Dania Beach, Hollywood, Davie, and Plantation.
- (3) One (1) fixed base operator at the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport.
- (4) One (1) representative of a local chapter of the Audubon Society.
- (5) One (1) representative of the Sierra Club.
- (6) One (1) member of the Broward Alliance.
- (7) One (1) member of the Lodging and Hospitality Association.
- (8) One (1) representative of a homeowners association from within the City of Dania Beach.
- (9) One (1) resident and member of the Edgewood Homeowners

Association within the City of Fort Lauderdale.

(10) One (1) member of the Port Everglades Association.

Terms: Serve at the pleasure of the Board or the appointing authority, as appropriate.

Failure to appear at any three (3) consecutive, regularly scheduled meetings of the Broward County Airport Task Force shall subject that member to removal by the appointing authority.

Quorum: Fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the total members appointed.
