

## How to Read the TIP Project Listings

Below is a sample TIP printout. The top heading indicates the general outline of information provided by this listing. The sections below the heading are sample data which are numbered and explained.

1. TIP # is a one to four digit Project Identification Number. These are generally numeric codes assigned by the MPO to track the projects.
2. Item Segment # is the Work Program Item and Segment number assigned by Florida Department of Transportation.
3. MPO District is the number of the MPO district.
4. Description or Limits describes the type of project or the beginning and ending locations of a project.
5. Type of Work is a brief description of the action or work being performed.
6. Length is the length of the work area in miles, not available for all projects.
7. Fund Source described in the funding source; e.g., Federal, States, or Local funds.
8. Phase is the primary phase of the project; e.g., Preliminary Engineering, Construction, or Utilities. See Explanation of Abbreviations.
9. Prior is the previous funding year.
