- International traffic: 8,608,363, up 19.8%

- Total traffic: 2,682,657, up 4.2%
- Domestic traffic: 2,105,501, up 4.7%
- International traffic: 577,156, up 2.6%
- YTD total traffic: 30,185,443, up 1.7%

New Service on the Books for 2019

- October - Spirit to Nashville
- November - Swoop to Winnipeg, Canada; Frontier to Cleveland and Cincinnati; Southwest to Cleveland, Louisville, Boston (Southwest is seasonal)
- December - Air Transat to Vancouver, Canada and Azul to Belo Horizonte, Brazil

Other Airline Developments

- Max update:
 - Air Canada and WestJet off the schedule until February
 - American, Southwest and United off the schedule until March

Passenger Traffic Outlook for Year/Season

- Thanksgiving passenger traffic is projected to be up approximately 6.8% during the period from November 26th through December 2nd
- Total scheduled seats for Q4/2019 and Q1/2020 are up 4.4% and 5.1%, respectively
- Passenger traffic should increase by approximately the same percentages
- Total passenger traffic for CY 2017 is estimated to be approximately 37M, up 3%
