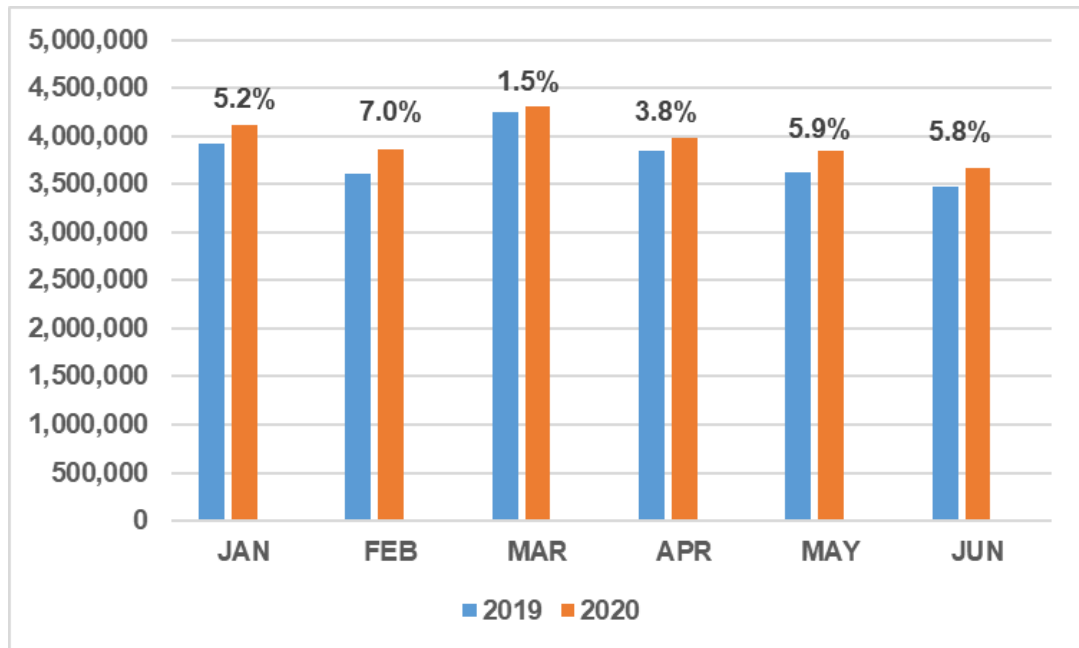
- April - Spirit to Oakland, California, Barranquilla and Bucaramanga in Colombia

- Boeing 737MAX:
 - American and Southwest off the schedule through August
 - United off the schedule through September

Outlook for 2020 (Jan-Jun)

- Scheduled seats up 4.9%
- Average of 7 more daily flights
- 4 fewer destinations served
- Total passenger traffic is expected to grow by approximately 5% for the six month period. The graph below depicts the month-over-month comparison of scheduled available seats. Passenger traffic should respond accordingly



- International seats are down -8.8% for the time period but are offset by a 9.4% increase on the domestic side.
